- 1. ALL competitors, owners, trainers, workers, lopers, family members and visitors MUST comply with current QLD Covid Restrictions in place at the time of the event. Failure to comply will result in cancellation of entries with no refund and removal from grounds.**
2. FULL PAYMENT must be received with all entries to be included in the draws.
3. DDCC reserves right to adjust start times and maintain control of all events
4. Uncleaned stables will incur a \$100 fee per stable cleaning fee.
5. All payouts are as per NCHA rulebook
6. DDCC will conduct the show in accordance with the NCHA Rule Book
7. DDCC assume no responsibility for accidents to horses, handlers or any other person.
- 8. PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR BANK ACCOUNT DETAILS AND GST STATUS ARE CORRECT IN ICOMPETE AS PAYOUTS WILL BE PAID DIRECTLY TO NOMINATED ACCOUNTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS INFORMATION.**
9. Any competitors travelling from interstate must email an approved border pass to Nadean prior to arriving at the grounds.
10. Electric fence areas must be paid with entries however MUST NOT be erected until a committee member has been consulted at the ground and is approval is granted. Anyone erecting an electric fence area without approval will be directed to remove the fence.
11. All events will be 1 round only with 3 head of cattle per competitor
