Terms and conditions

- 1. Entries Via I-compete for NCHA events including unaffiliated any problems contact the NCHA.
- 2. Committee reserves the right to alter the program at any time due to any reason.
- 3. Late entries may not be accepted and if are, will be accepted at discretion of show committee and shall be placed at the end of the first available heard and no extra cattle are required to be allocated for that entry.
- 4. It is the rider/competitor's responsibility to understand the NCHA/WGQHA rules and to ensure that your entries are true and correct. The committee holds no responsibility for the entries of the competitors.
- 5. Scratching will be accepted up to 4 full days before the show date and must be done via iCompete i.e. Monday before show weekend at 11.59 PM.
- 6. There will be 2.5 head of fresh cattle per run except Improver and Youth Improver will be rerun cattle. Preworks is 2 head of fresh cattle for 3 minutes.
- 7. Futurity Preworks when applicable will be 3 head of fresh cattle for 5 minutes.
- 8. Cancellations will be fully repaid minus costs incurred by the club. Example cattle hire, NCHA fees, admin costs, ETC.
- 9. Any person riding a horse at an event must either be a current NCHA member or pay a NCHA event fee this includes all competitors, lopers and horse helpers.
- 10. There is a 9pm noise and generator curfew.
- 11. Horse yards are first in best dressed, must be left clean & place chains back on horse yards after use. BYO Yards accepted, however here is to be no horse/tape yards to be built in the middle grass Island either side of the shelter/canteen area.
- 12. Clean up horse manure/feed and must be placed in buckers provided around grounds.
- 13. There is to be no tying horses to trees on the grounds.
- 14. The show will conduct in accordance with the NCHA rule book. The committee assume no responsibility for accidents, to horses, handlers, and/or any other person.
- 15. To gain WGQHA high points you need to do a minimum 3 shows and be an approved financial member before any points are gained. Must follow ALL relevant WGQHA Rules.
- 16. All ground rules apply
- 17. All Victorian Statuary Requirement must be adhered to.
